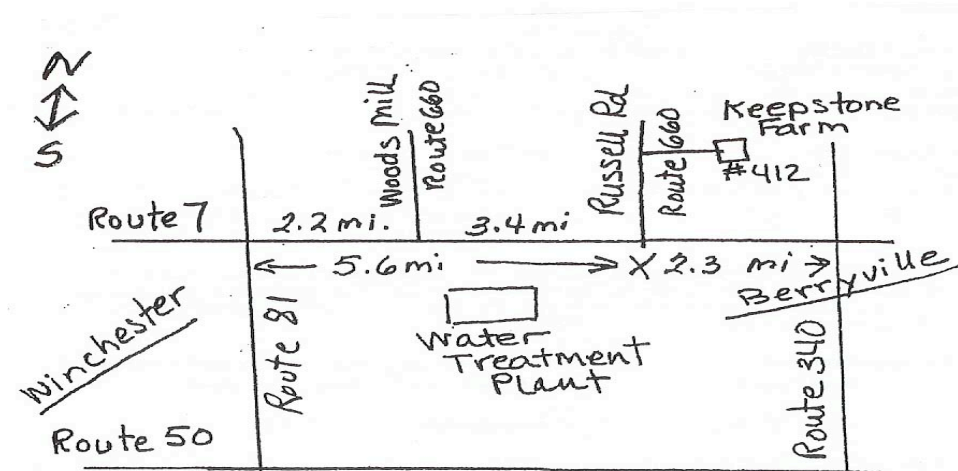

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**HANDLERS MEETING:** There will be a handlers meeting at the beginning of each class.

**LUNCH BREAK** will be scheduled at the judge's discretion.

**FOOD:** Complimentary coffee and donuts in the morning. Soft drinks and water can be purchased all day. Please bring your lunch, chairs and shade. Volunteer lunches will be provided.

**ENTRIES:**

A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog entered. A single form may be used for BOTH days ONLY if classes entered are the same.

Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Entries WITHOUT fees and signatures on Entry Form will NOT be accepted.

**ALL OVERNIGHT OR REGISTERED MAIL MUST WAIVE SIGNATURE!**

No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of CCWCC will be made after the closing date.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date. After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of CCWCC it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial classes, no refund will be made.

CCWCC may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against CCWCC or any official thereof.

MOVE UP REQUESTS must be made to the trial secy. 30 minutes before the start of the EVENT

BITCHES IN SEASON will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the test classes and will run in catalog order in the trial classes. Please notify the test/trial secretary as soon as possible so schedule adjustments can be made.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except while in the test/trial arena. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena – this includes BARKING dogs. All dogs must be kept at least 20 feet from arena fences during test/trial runs. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club HERDING REGULATIONS.)
